Form B: Consent form for the use of photographs, film or video recordings of children or vulnerable adults

The Rotary Club of South Woodham Ferrers has adopted the Rotary GB&I Safeguarding Policies (Children and Vulnerable Adults).

In accordance with the Rotary GB&I Safeguarding Policies and procedures, where possible, the Rotary Club will not permit photographs, film, video or other images of children or vulnerable adults to be taken or used unless the consent of their parent/guardian or carer has been obtained, in addition, where appropriate, the consent of the child/vulnerable adult will also be sought.

The Rotary club will take all reasonable measures to ensure these images are used solely for the purposes for which they are intended. Any person becoming aware that these images are being used inappropriately should immediately inform the safeguarding officer of the Rotary club.

The Rotary club reserves the right at all times to prohibit the use of photography, film or video at any activity with which it is associated.
