To everyone who donated to the Rotary Club of South Woodham Ferrers and Rotary Club of Saarbrucken Ukraine Appeal,

On behalf of everyone here at ShelterBox, thank you so much for this incredible collective effort.

Your combined donation of £4,130 will go to support families affected by the crisis in Ukraine. Any additional money raised will help in other countries where ShelterBox provides emergency shelter.

I wanted to share the latest update so that you can picture the impact your generous support will have on the ground.

We are working on three projects – two in Ukraine and one supporting those fleeing the county.

- 1) We are providing mattresses to collective centres in Lviv, Ukraine. Working with People in Need, we began distributions in March and the delivery of mattresses is continuing throughout April. Collective centres are places where people are seeking shelter and safety. The mattresses will help people sleep at night.
- 2) We have started distributing shelter kits and other essential items to help people in Ukraine survive in damaged buildings. The kits contain tarpaulins, tools and rope, thermal blankets, solar lights, buckets and water carriers as well as hygiene items like soap, washing powder and toothpaste.
- 3) We will be supporting refugees in neighbouring countries with high priority items they can carry with them, like hygiene items and cash. Our teams are working with government representatives, other humanitarian organisations and Rotary in Moldova to draw up our plans. Our team has been visiting collective centres as well as conducting needs assessments at a reception centre in Moldova not far from the border with Ukraine, where many refugees have been arriving.



On behalf of everyone here, thank you so much for your generosity, and for all the Rotary Club of South Woodham Ferrers and Rotary Club of Saarbrucken share and do, both in your local communities and far beyond.
